ADIRONDACK WINERY WINS NORTHEAST REGION SPIRIT OF STRIDES AWARD

Local winery won the regional award for its work supporting Making Strides Against Breast Cancer of the Adirondacks

(Queensbury, N.Y.) – Adirondack Winery was recently awarded the Spirit of Strides Award for the Northeast Region. This past October, the company raised over \$20,000 for Making Strides Against Breast Cancer of the Adirondacks, bringing its total fundraising efforts over the past 10 years to over \$100,000.

Adirondack Winery beat over 20 other organizations that were nominated for the Spirit of Strides Award. Making Strides Against Breast Cancer organizations from 11 northeast states submitted nominations. Spirit of Strides Awards are intended to honor and recognize community partners that embody the relentless Making Strides Against Breast Cancer spirit and commitment that has propelled the success of this movement for more than two decades.

Adirondack Winery is now one of six Spirit of Strides award winners being considered for a national award. The results of the national award will be announced in January. "As the staff partner for this event and a breast cancer caregiver myself, this event and team make me so proud. They inspire many (including myself) and what I love the most is that they were nominated by a volunteer that was so moved by their efforts. The region is better because the winery is a part of it," said Nick Liporace, Senior Development Manager of the Capital Region American Cancer Society.

From mid-September to the end of October, a portion of every purchase made at Adirondack Winery was donated to Making Strides. With the support of its customers, staff, friends, family, and other local businesses, the winery was able to raise over \$5,000 more than the initial \$15,000 goal set in September.

Adirondack Winery was the Flagship Sponsor of the local Making Strides event in Glens Falls on Sunday, Oct. 23.

Over the past ten years, Adirondack Winery has raised over \$100,000 for Making Strides Against Breast Cancer of the Adirondacks during its Drink Pink fundraiser, and they don't plan to stop any time soon. They hope to hit a new record next year with their 11th Annual Drink Pink Fundraiser.
