LOCAVORE SAMPLER
\$5 per person, not shareable
Features locally made soft cheese or hard cheese, premium cracker, chocolate truffle, wine infused marshmallow or cookie and wine infused jelly.



CHEESE LOVERS SAMPLER
\$5 per person, not shareable
Features a locally made soft cheese, a hard cheese, wine infused crackers, a locally made parmesan cheese crisp and cheese straws.



GLUTEN SENSITIVE SAMPLER
\$5 per person, not shareable
Features a locally made Parmesan cheese crisp, wine dried raisins, wine chips, locally made hard cheese and wine infused popcorn.

The minimum group accepted is 5 people, while the maximum is:

- 10 people in one group reservation time slot of 1 hour for the Lake George Tasting Room
- 10 people in one group reservation time slot of 1 hour 30 minutes in Bolton Landing Tasting Room

LARGE GROUP TASTING EXPERIENCE POLICIES:

Group Size: Reservations are accepted for groups of 5 or more during our regular operating hours.

Lake George Tasting Room:

- We can accommodate up to 10 guests at one reservation time at our Lake George Tasting Room. The group may not be split up over other reservations in Lake George to accommodate the party size. No exceptions. Parties of 5 – 10 have 1 hour to complete their tasting. Additional time may not be purchased.

Bolton Landing Tasting Room:

- We can accommodate up to 10 guests at one reservation time at our Bolton Landing Tasting Room. The group may not be split up over other reservations in Bolton Landing to accommodate the party size. No exceptions. Parties of 5 – 10 have 1 hour and 30 minutes to complete their tasting. Additional time may not be purchased. Open seasonally, April through November.

Scheduling: Group reservation times will be considered on a case-by-case basis by our Tasting Room or Club Manager. Reservations are encouraged to be booked 1 month before the event date. Any time after that we cannot always guarantee availability. Group must conform to the reservation time slots available. There will be no altering of reservation time to accommodate groups.

Reservation Timing: We will start the group when all guests have arrived and are seated. If the group is more than 10 minutes late, we will attempt to reschedule or re-accommodate. If you are late to your tasting and decide that you would still like to proceed, you will still be required to complete the tasting in the original allotted time frame. If that is not possible, no refund will be issued, and money will not be put toward any in-store purchases.

Parking: Parking is limited at all locations and all members of the group are encouraged to plan on arriving 20 minutes ahead of schedule. The Tasting Room will do their best to seat you earlier or on time for your reservation.

Reservation Length: When booking a reservation, you are agreeing to the start and end time allocated. Each location runs off a back-to-back reservation system and has a different length of allotted time per location. You cannot pay any additional money to extend group time, regardless of party size or if running late.

Lake George: 1 hour per group - Bolton Landing: 1hr 30 minutes per group

Payment: Your reservation is not confirmed until full payment has been made at the time of booking. Payments for the reservation cannot be split or made the day of.

A la carte items can be added the day of and can be paid for by individuals at the tasting.

Outside Food and Beverage: No outside food and beverage is permitted in Adirondack Winery Tasting Rooms. We offer an assortment of sodas and food items that can be purchased at the tasting.

Refund Policy: Adirondack Winery's Pre-Sold Tasting Experiences are non-refundable. If you need to modify your reservation, contact us at 518-203-2597, at least 24 hours before your reservation time, and we will attempt to schedule another time slot for your reservation. If we are not able to accommodate you, your fee WILL NOT be refunded. If you are more than 10 mins late to your reservation, your reservation may be forfeited to another guest and will not be refunded. You can always transfer your reservation.

Tasting Space: Please understand that Adirondack Winery's Tasting Rooms are licensed New York State Satellite Retail Locations; therefore, we are only licensed to pour tastings of our wines and sell bottles for off-premises consumption. We do not serve wine by the glass or other traditional "wine bar" amenities. Our Lake George Tasting Room DOES NOT include a restroom, while Bolton Landing does.

- Large group reservations do not have a "private space". A section of our bar will be reserved for your group guests. The space is open to the public and your guests will be served alongside our regular customers. Space may be limited for your party based on how many customers we have in the space at any time.

ID / Non-Tasting Guests: Guests must present a valid photo ID (*United States Driver's License or DMV issued Non-Driver ID, Passport, or Military ID*) showing age 21+ to taste. Space is only reserved for members of the group participating in the tasting.

- If guests are under 21 and are seen handling wine, they may be asked to leave the premises and purchases may be denied, avoiding the appearance of breaking State and Federal laws.

Behavior: Adirondack Winery's Tasting Room is not a bar. We ask that you please drink responsibly, before, during and after your tasting and that safe driving is ensured. Our Tasting Room staff may refuse service to a member of your party if they are intoxicated or acting irresponsibly. We may request that member(s) of your group be removed from the Tasting Room. All members are expected to be respectful of other guests and the staff. Adirondack Winery associates can ask group guests to act in a respectable manner, if not doing so. No refunds will be issued if any members of your group are required to leave due to lack of ID, intoxication, or unacceptable behavior.
