Sasha Pardy, Adirondack Winery President and Co-Owner continued, "We're bringing the winery to where the people are, as opposed to where the vineyards are. We strong believe in 'try before you buy', so a visit to the winery means customers enjoy a wine tasting session that includes a souvenir glass. They can also browse our wide selection of wine-related accessories and gifts, gourmet cheeses and chocolates, and more. We are excited to bring our quality wines as well as something new and different to Lake George Village – we have been thrilled with the reception from both local and visiting customers."

With a strong focus on the local region, Adirondack Winery's selection of red, white, dessert and fruity wines are all labeled with photographs featuring scenery and landmarks of the Warren/Washington/Saratoga County region.
