

Being a "new" wine for ADK Winery, we wanted to improve on the tasting profile of the original California grape version of Amethyst Sunset by bringing out more fresh blackberry flavors. We accomplished that by using 5 different grapes which mostly have a neutral profile for taste as blackberry can be fairly subtle so it needed that neutral base to shine.
