Tasting Notes

This medium bodied dry rose wine brings out expressive notes of strawberry on the nose and palette followed by light notes of raspberry and vanilla. Berry jams and sauces are noticed while delving into a cold crisp glass of this year’s vintage on a nice summer day.

Food Pairing Notes

While perfect for hot summer days, this wine complements herb crusted goat cheese or grilled chicken with mixed vegetables.

Winemaker Notes

The Cabernet Franc grapes are pressed immediately, whereas our red wines we let ferment in bins with skins on for 2 weeks. This is what gives the wine the light color of pink and a lower level of tannins than traditional Cabernet Franc dry red wine.
