Tasting Notes

Winemaker Notes

After aging an additional 12 months in American oak barrels, our 2018 Meritage transformed into 2018 Meritage Reserve. The extra aging gives this wine a bold nose and perception of a boozier taste compared to the original version; however, a smooth finish is noticed on the palate due to the mellowing wood extraction.
