The 2020 harvest season brought a new and exciting opportunity for the winemaking team to create a Lemberger Rosé on the heels of winning, Best in Class of Lemberger's, for our 2018 Stargazer. The first thing noticed with this rosé is its unique color. Rather than a dull pink, this wine exudes a gorgeous fuchsia that was a result of an 18-hour soak followed by a saignée.
